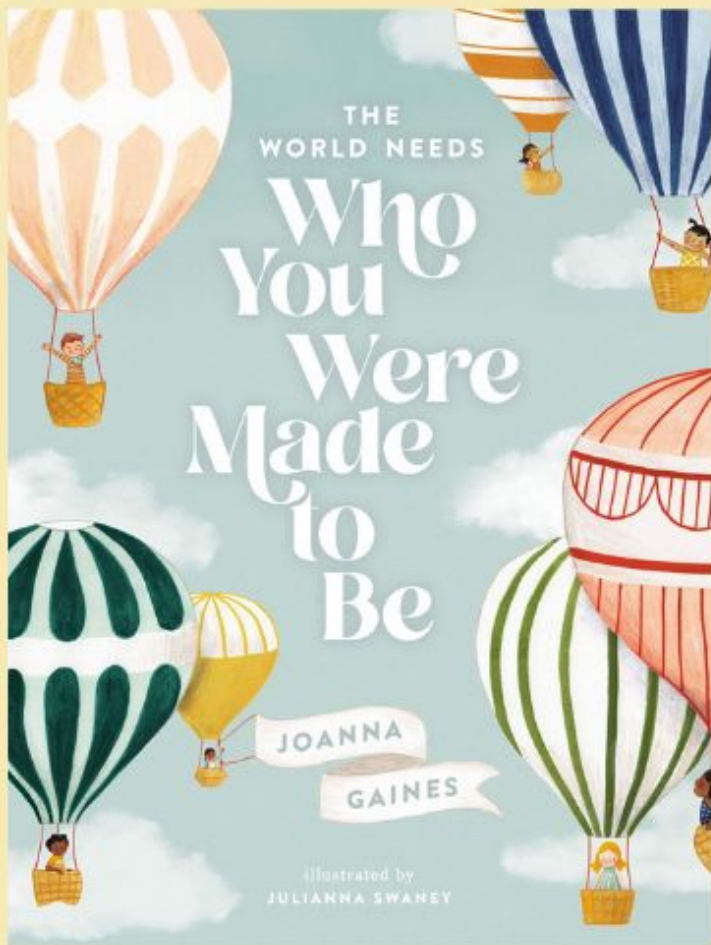

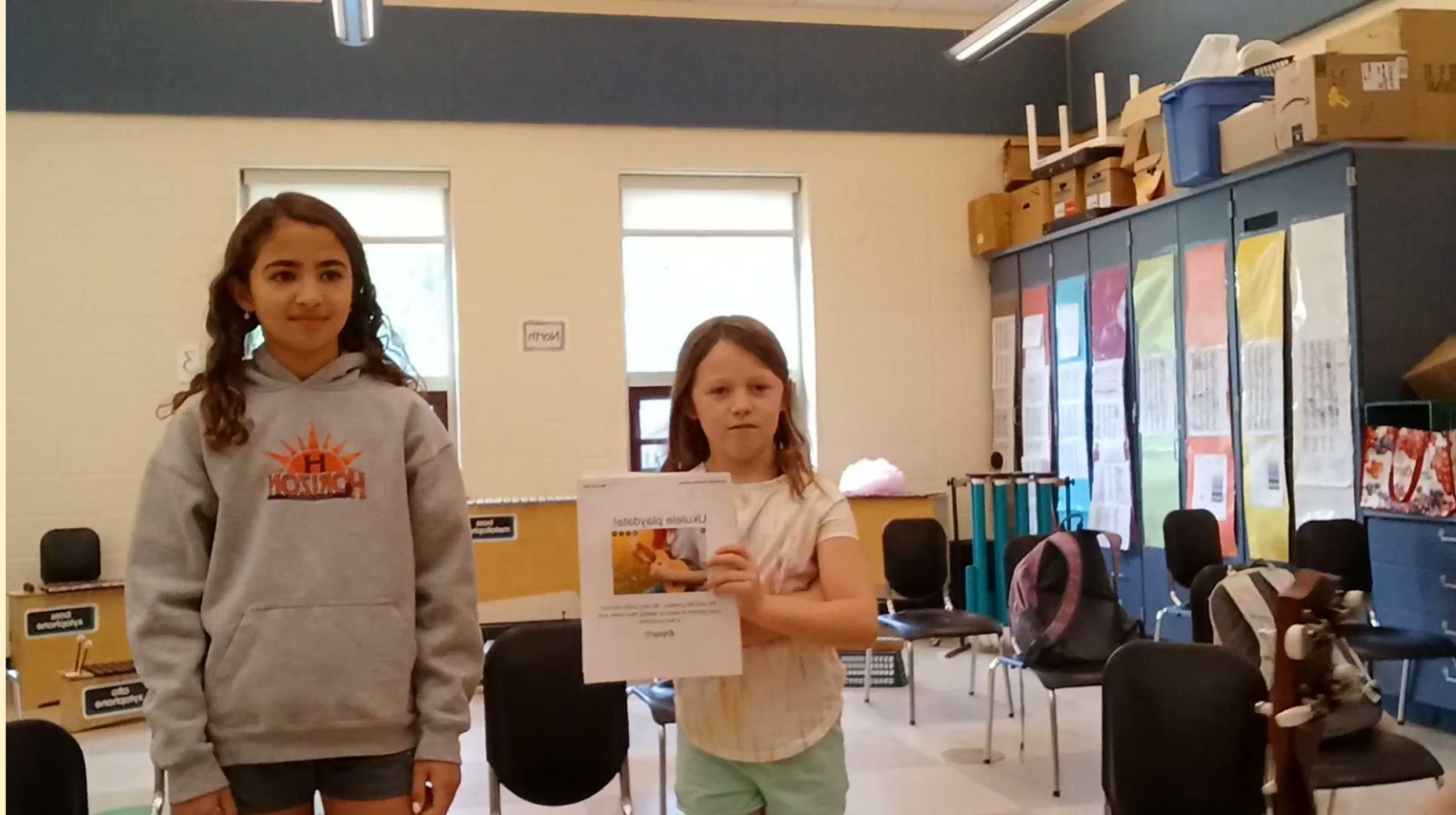

all kinds of people.



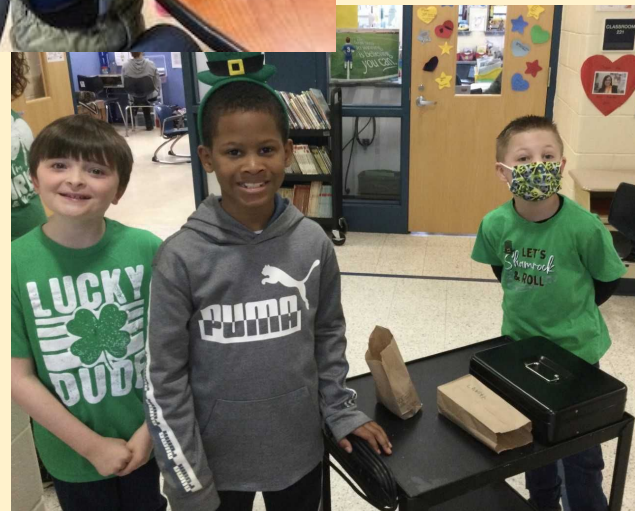
