

# Best Tips for Cleaning and Sanitizing iPads

Tablets and other touch-sensitive devices are fun and easy to use. But with all those hands and fingers tapping away, it's a good idea to clean and sanitize them regularly. Here are a few tips:

## Cleaning an iPad NOT in an OtterBox case:

1. Unplug all cables and turn off iPad (press and hold the Sleep/Wake button, and then slide the onscreen slider).
2. Use a soft, slightly damp, lint-free cloth. Use **only water**. Avoid getting moisture in openings.

**NOTE: Don't use window cleaners, household cleaners, compressed air, aerosol sprays, solvents, ammonia, abrasives, or cleaners containing hydrogen peroxide to clean iPad.**

3. An iPad has a special coating on its screen; simply wipe the iPad's screen with a soft, lint-free cloth to remove oil left by your hands. The ability of this coating to repel oil will diminish over time with normal usage, and rubbing the screen with an abrasive material will further diminish its effect and may scratch your screen.



## Cleaning an iPad in an OtterBox case:

1. Wipe the screen protector of any debris. You can use any dry, clean cloth.
2. Dampen the cloth with warm, soapy water and gently wipe the surface of the OtterBox screen to remove any dirt not removed by the dry cloth. To avoid streaks, gently wipe with a dry cloth until all moisture has dissipated.
3. Quickly sanitize your OtterBox with a sanitized wipe or a tissue with hand sanitizer to keep your case germ-free.
