

# NPE Fifth Grade Art Club

Fifth grade art club is open to all fifth graders. Students can sign up for art club at the beginning of the school year. After signing up, a permission form will be sent home for parents to sign. Art club is held in the art room on Thursdays, right after school from 3:30 – 4:30 pm. There will be **NO** art club on parent/teacher conference days or in the case of early dismissal.

The main art club project is to make a water fountain out of clay. The fountain will have a water basin, a spout, and a real water pump. The students will design their fountain and plan how they want the water to flow.
