SUMMER SCHOOL</p> <p>It is the policy of the Board that the district may conduct a summer program of remedial and enrichment instruction for resident students of this district and such other students as the Board may admit.</p> <p>In order to support a program of summer instruction, the Board shall:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Employ teaching and administrative staff. 2. Purchase necessary books, materials, supplies, and equipment. 3. Utilize schools or other facilities required. 4. Provide necessary custodial services. <p>Planned instruction offered in summer school may be designed as credit or noncredit offerings.</p> <p>Tuition fees established by the Board shall be charged to all students who participate.</p> <p><u>Summer School Scholarships</u></p> <p>The Board recognizes the educational benefits students gain from participating in the summer school program. Since the summer school is a self-supporting program, the Board further recognizes the desirability of providing scholarships for students from the district who should attend summer school but need financial assistance to do so.</p> <p>The Board shall encourage organizations within the school district to support such scholarships, with selection procedures determined jointly by the administrative team and the contributing organization. Such organizations should notify the Summer School Coordinator or Director of Curriculum of their intent by April 1.</p>
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<p>3. Delegation of Responsibility</p>	<p>The Superintendent or designee shall be responsible for the summer school program.</p> <p>Guidelines for the operation of summer school shall be consistent with Board policies, and the operation of summer school shall not conflict in any way with administration of the regular school sessions of this district.</p> <p>References:</p> <p>School Code – 24 P.S.
