STUDENT USE OF SCHOOL LOANED INSTRUMENTS</p> <p>The Wallingford-Swarthmore School District may purchase or rent for student use instruments from the following families of instruments:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Brass</li> <li>• Percussion</li> <li>• Strings</li> <li>• Woodwinds</li> </ul> <p>Students using school loaned instruments will be evaluated after a period of six (6) months. If the teacher determines that the student is doing well, teacher will confer with the parents/guardians and encourage them to purchase their own instrument. In the event that the student is not doing well, student will be encouraged to return the instrument so that it may be used by another student. Evidence of mistreatment of the instrument will be reason to terminate the loan.</p> <p>A loan agreement will be signed by the parent/guardian covering repairs other than normal depreciation and loss.</p> <p>It is expected that the life span of the instrument be at least ten (10) years. When an instrument reaches a condition in which it is no longer economically feasible to retain, it will be disposed of according to District policy.</p>
