1. Purpose	<p>Homework assignments should complement classroom instruction. Assignments should develop student responsibility, good study habits and organizational skills.</p> <p>The purpose of homework assignments should be to:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Provide practice and reinforcement of skills already presented by the teacher.2. Broaden areas of interest through enrichment.3. Provide opportunities for parents to know what their child is studying.4. Encourage parent and child interaction.
2. Guidelines	<p>Homework should not interfere with the proper development of the student's health, nor should it interfere with the student assuming responsibilities in the home.</p> <p>Homework will not be assigned as a form of punishment.</p> <p>Assignments will be reviewed and returned within a reasonable amount of time.</p> <p>In all disciplines, review of homework should include checking for proper grammar usage and correct spelling, as well as for content.</p>
