205. POSTGRADUATE STUDENTS	
1. Purpose	This policy shall provide guidelines to allow community members educational opportunities within the public schools they support.
2. Authority SC 502, 1901  Pol. 607	<p>The Board will consider the admittance of resident postgraduate students over twenty-one (21) years of age, under special circumstances, to regular classes.</p> <p>Tuition shall be at the rate established by the Board.</p>
3. Guidelines	<p>The Board may approve the courses available to postgraduate students based on course content, and projected class enrollment by resident students.</p> <p>The continued attendance of each admitted postgraduate student shall be contingent upon maintenance of a satisfactory academic performance, regular attendance, and a record of good conduct.</p>
4. Delegation of Responsibility	The Superintendent must approve each qualified applicant for postgraduate studies before the student may begin such studies. Such approval shall not be construed to extend beyond the course for which application is made.
