REPORTING STUDENT PROGRESS</p> <p>Purpose The Board recognizes that communication between school and home is a vital component in the growth and education of each student. The Board acknowledges the school's responsibility to keep parents/guardians informed of student welfare and academic progress.[1]</p> <p>Authority The Board directs that the District’s instructional program shall include a system of measuring all students’ academic progress.[2][3][4][5]</p> <p>The Board directs the Superintendent to establish a system of reporting student progress that includes academic progress reports, grade reports, and parent/guardian conferences with teachers.</p> <p>Delegation of Responsibility The Superintendent or designee shall develop administrative regulations for reporting student progress to parents/guardians.</p> <p>All appropriate staff members, as part of their professional responsibility, shall comply with the systems established for measuring and reporting student progress.[2][3]</p> <p>Guidelines Various methods of reporting, appropriate to grade level and curriculum content, shall be utilized.</p> <p>Conferences with parents/guardians shall be used as an integral part of the reporting system. Scheduling of parent-teacher conferences shall occur at times that ensure the greatest degree of participation by parents/guardians.</p> <p>Review and evaluation of methods of reporting student progress to parents/guardians shall be conducted on a periodic basis.</p> <p>Legal 1.
