EDUCATIONAL PROGRAMS FOR NONRESIDENT STUDENTS</p> <p>The school district recognizes that the presence of specific nonresident United States students may be of significant benefit to the residents of the district and the participants. Special programs sponsored by recognized organizations for the educational advancement of students from other areas will be considered by the district.</p> <p>Students may be considered nonresidents when their custodial parent/guardian resides in another school district.</p> <p>Each program request shall be submitted to the Superintendent annually for review, evaluation, and presentation to the Board. If the Board approves the program, the participants will receive the benefits of school attendance for that academic year.</p> <p>A nonresident tuition waiver of one hundred percent (100%) will be granted to a maximum of twenty (20) students per year from recognized educational programs with no more than ten (10) students from any one program.</p> <p><u>Clarification</u></p> <p>All other nonresident United States students will be subject to the policies on nonresident students.</p>
