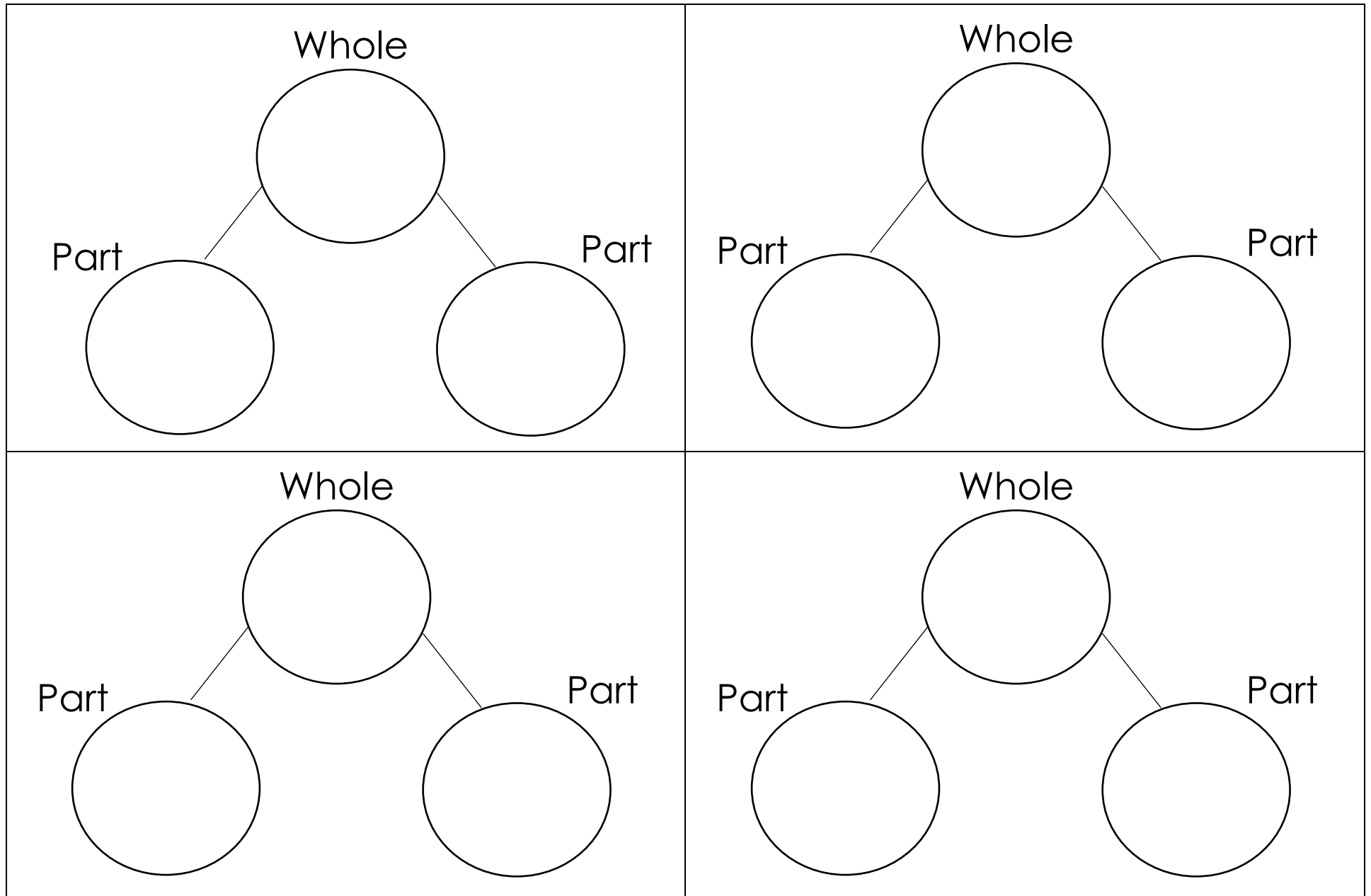
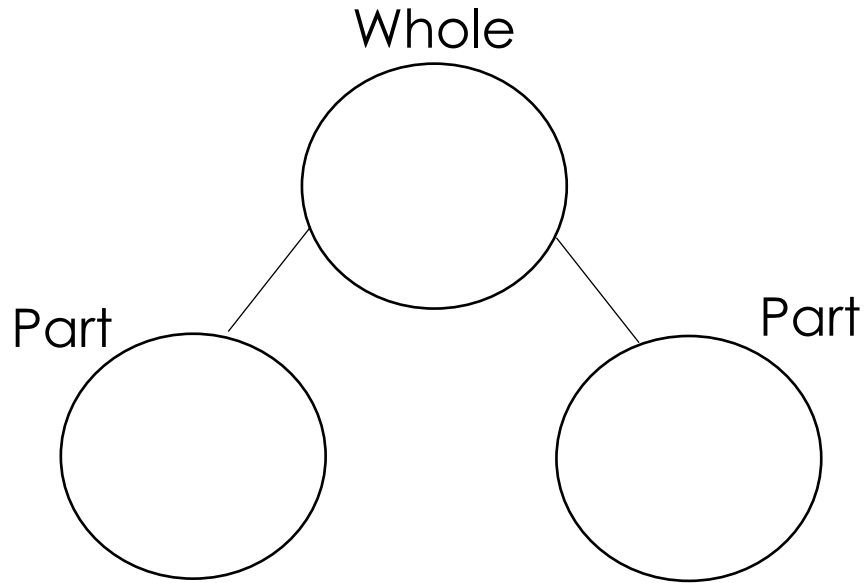


Number Bonds Template: Vertical with Whole on Top

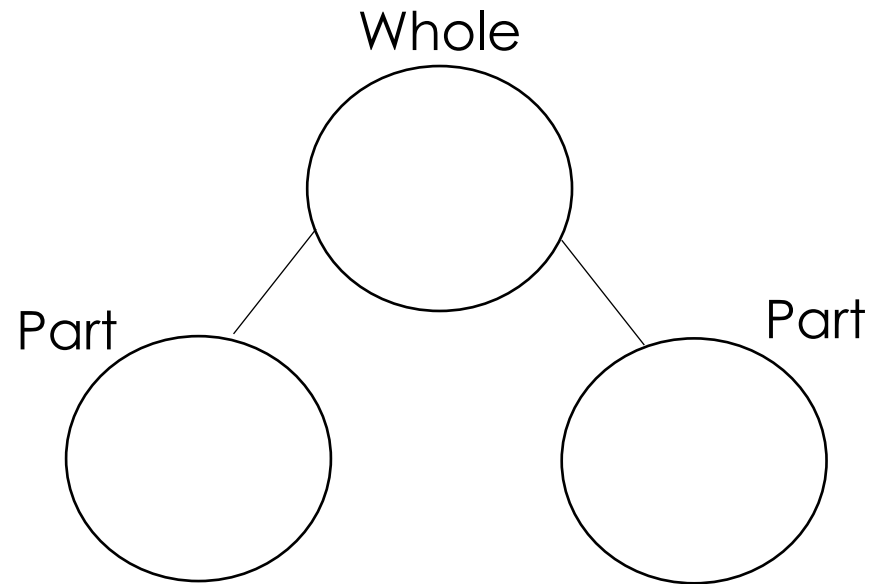


Number Bonds: Part and Part Make Whole -or- Part + Part = Whole

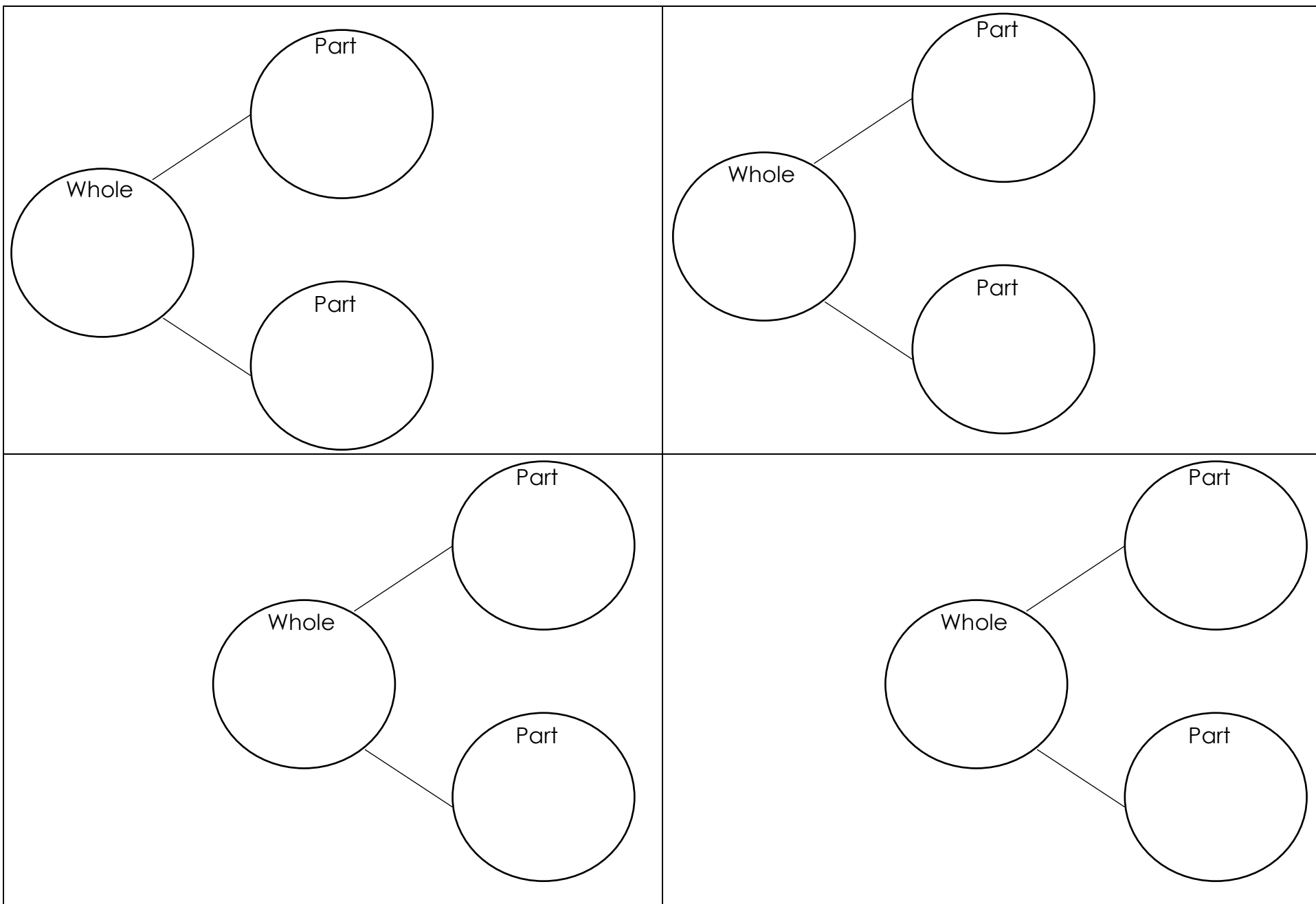

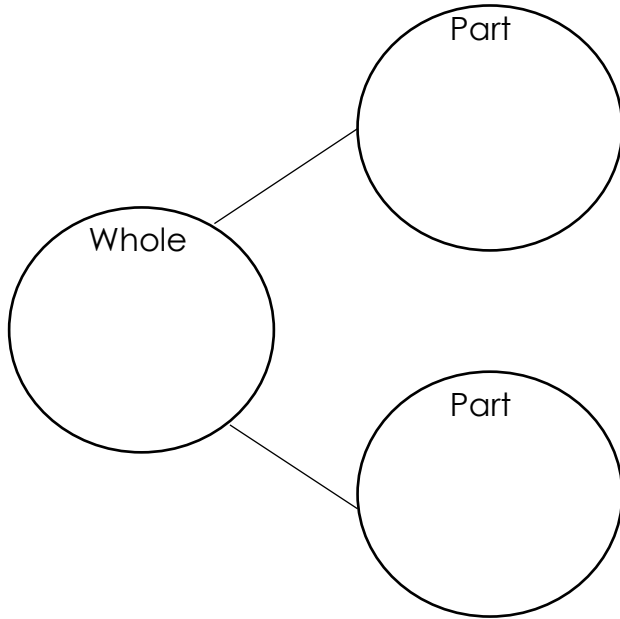

Number Bonds Template: Horizontal with Whole on Top

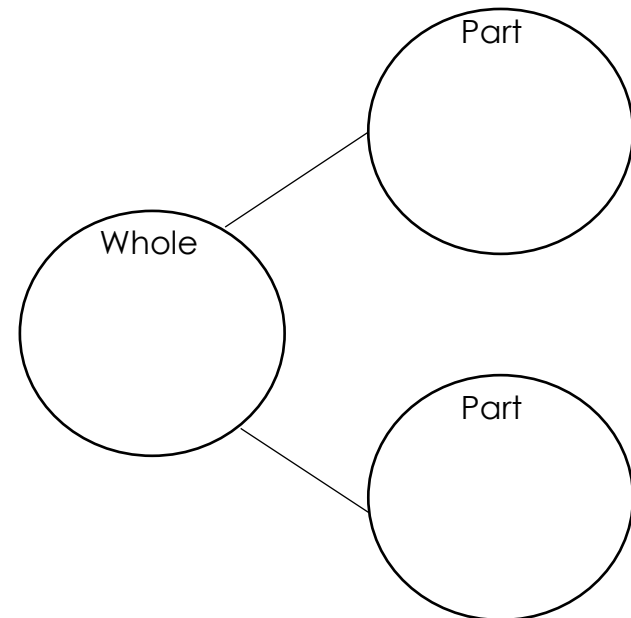
