




Math and English Language Arts (ELA)

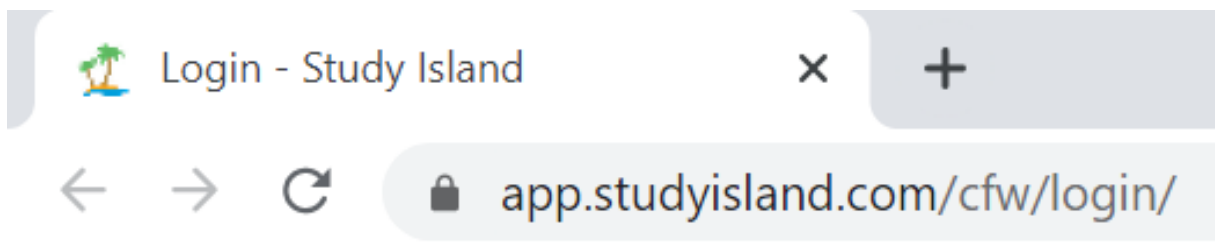

3. Enter your username and password then select “Sign In.”

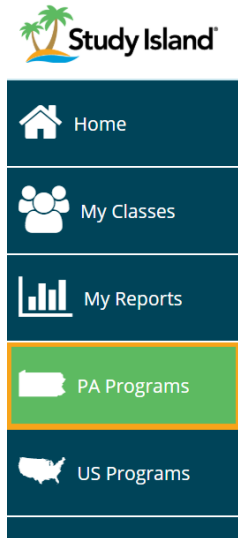

Example selects Math (PA Core) - Edition 2. ELA (PA Core) – Edition 2 also available.

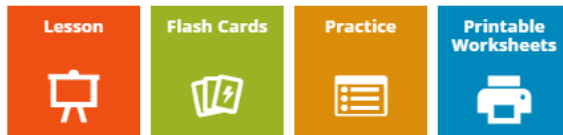


7. Select **blue hyperlinked text** to view resources for desired topic

9. Children will receive a:

- Blue Ribbon – Indicates that the child passed the topic.
 - If the child's overall percentage correct is at least 70% in the subject, a game mode option is available after earning the blue ribbon.
- Yellow Triangle – Indicates that the child needs additional work on the topic.
 - In most cases, they will be given access to a Building Block Topic, which they must pass before returning to the on-grade-level topic.
- White Ribbon – Indicates that the child passed the Building Block Topic.
