This letter is being sent to inform you of the remediation options since your student has earned a D or F in one or more of their courses this year.

**If a student earns a D in a course:** They *do earn* academic credit for the course, but in some cases this grade might not be sufficient to advance to the next course in a sequence.

**If a student earns an F in a course:** No academic credit is awarded. If the course is a core course and required as part of the academic program, the course will either have to be repeated at SHHS or remediated through an approved summer course program.

## What are the options for repeating a course or recovering a credit?

• Repeating a course: A student is enrolled in the same course at SHHS for the 2023-2024 academic year. There is no cost to the student or family. The course that is being re-taken replaces an elective.

The initial course will appear on the transcript but the originally earned grade will be replaced by the letter R. This repeated course will appear on a student's transcript. The new grade from SHHS will be calculated into the student's GPA. The original grade from the SHHS course, now listed as an R, will not be calculated into GPA.

• <u>In-Person/ Hybrid WSSD Summer Credit Recovery and Enrichment</u>: This hybrid model requires in-person attendance for 14 days in July for face-to-face learning that supports the completion of online modules.

The initial course taken at SHHS will appear on the transcript followed by the letter R. The course name and the grade the student earned in the summer credit recovery and enrichment course will be recorded on the student's transcript. Neither the new grade from the approved external provider nor the original SHHS course, now listed as an R on the transcript, will be calculated into GPA. With the exception of a \$50 refundable deposit upon successful credit acquisition, this program is provided at no cost to a student. Please contact your school counselor if you need financial assistance for the \$50 deposit. Registration can be found here and is not complete until a \$50 check is received by Doris Ford at the SHHS Main Office. Please write the check to WSSD and write your child's name in the memo line.

• <u>Online Credit Recovery Course</u>: This is an online summer remediation course offered through a pre-approved external provider.

The course name and the grade the student earned in the summer remediation course will be recorded on the student's transcript. The initial course taken at SHHS will appear on the transcript followed by the letter R. Neither the new grade from the approved external provider nor the original SHHS course, now listed as an R on the transcript, will be calculated into GPA. The cost of these online courses is borne entirely by the student/family.

The course(s) listed below are the course(s) that earned a grade of F or D:

Failing course(s) will automatically appear on your student's schedule next year until/unless a credit remediation course is completed.

These in-person credit recovery courses are designed to be completed by the end of the July in-person sessions.

Should a student require additional time to complete any online assignments, the credit recovery courses must be completed no later than August 7, 2023 to be applied to the student's transcript. After July 27, 2023 support will be provided online up until completion of the coursework on August 7.

While work is completed with in-person support, all assignments are submitted digitally and assessed by an Edgenuity/Imagine Learning teacher who is a PA-certified. The Edgenuity/Imagine Learning teacher assigns grades on all assignments as well as the final grade for the course.

In anticipation of any unit of study, Edgenuity/Imagine Learning provides a pre-test that identifies specific modules and topics that are required of the student. Students will not need to complete coursework that the pre-test indicates the student already has mastered.

Coursework begins on July 5th and continues Monday through Thursday until July 27th for a total of 14 days. Each day, sessions will run from 8:30am - 11:30am with transportation provided by the District. Attendance is required for all in-person sessions. Any student who misses three or more in-person sessions will not be eligible to have their deposit refunded. All credit recovery courses must be completed and official transcripts must be received in the Counseling Department no later than August 7, 2023 regardless of the program's stated course deadline for credit to be applied to the student's transcript.
