**Kindergarten ~ *Teachers may send home an individual class supply list that differs slightly from this list. Students are not expected to have supplies the first week of school.***

- Backpack (large enough to hold a folder and snack)
- Two-pocket folder for home-school communication
- Glue sticks (3)
- Colored pencils, 24/bx
- Healthy snack and drink each day

*Optional:*

- Tissues

**First Grade ~ *Teachers may send home an individual class supply list that differs slightly from this list. Students are not expected to have supplies the first week of school.***

- School bag labeled with child's name
- Plastic pencil box
- 6 large sized glue sticks
- 1 set of thick markers-non scented
- 1 set of thin markers-non scented
- 1 box 24 crayons
- 2 boxes of sharpened #2 pencils (Ticonderoga sharpen the best!!)
- 8 THIN dry erase markers (Expo brand black is preferred but any color will do)
- 3 **PLASTIC** two-pocket folders
- 1 pair of small scissors
- Clipboard labeled with your child's name
- 1 box of tissues
- 1 pack of colored pencils
- Headphones in a Ziploc page labeled with child's name
- 1 large pink eraser
- Small manual pencil sharpener to keep in desk (enclosed to catch the shavings)
- 1 box of Ziploc bags (either sandwich, quart or gallon)

**Second Grade ~ *Teachers may send home an individual class supply list that differs slightly from this list. Students are not expected to have supplies the first week of school.***

- School bag/backpack labeled with student's name
- 2 packages of thick markers
- 1 package of thin markers
- Set of colored pencils
- 6 glue sticks
- Pencil box or case with one package (12) sharpened pencils (Ticonderoga sharpen most easily!)
- Small pencil sharpener
- 2 big pencil erasers
- 2 two-pocket folders, marked with student's name
- Marble-type composition book
- 2 boxes of tissues
- 3 dry-erase markers
- 1 container of baby wipes
- 1 package 3x3 sticky notes (Post-Its)

**Third Grade ~ *Teachers may send home an individual class supply list that differs slightly from this list. Students are not expected to have supplies the first week of school.***

- Composition/spiral notebook
- Colored pencils
- 2 boxes of tissues
- 4 two- pocket folders
- Dry erase marker
- 2 Glue sticks

Fourth Grade ~ *Teachers may send home an individual class supply list that differs slightly from this list. Students are not expected to have supplies the first week of school.*

- 2 lined composition books
- 4 2-pocket folders
- 2 packs of sharpened pencils
- 1 set of colored pencils (crayons and/or markers may also be useful)
- 3 packs of Post-It notes (3x3 inch or larger)
- 2 different colored highlighters
- 2 glue sticks
- 1 pair of child-safe scissors
- 1 12-inch (standard/metric) ruler
- 5-6 dry erase markers
- 2 boxes of facial tissues
- 1 set of headphones/earbuds (inexpensive – to be used with computers)
- Positive attitude
- Respect for yourself and others
- Willingness to consistently put forth your best effort

Fifth Grade ~ *Teachers may send home an individual class supply list that differs slightly from this list. Students are not expected to have supplies the first week of school.*

- Pens ~ red, blue and black (3 of each color)
- Pencils ~ 48 pencils (no refillable lead pencils)
- Post It Notes ~ flags (1 pack) and 3x3 (5 packs)
- Markers and/or colored pencils (1 pack)
- Sharpie Marker ~ 2 **THIN TIP** (black)
- Pencil Case or Zip-lock bag (no hard cases)
- Scissors
- Erasers
- Highlighter (2)
- Glue sticks (2)
- Dry erase markers ~ (3 any color)
- Headphones/earbuds (inexpensive)
- Tissues (3 boxes)
- Composition notebooks (4) 1 red, 1 blue, 1 yellow, 1 green
- Graph paper composition books for math (2 student preference on size)
- Folders (4) 1 red, 1 blue, 1 yellow, 1 green
- 3-ring binder 1” (1 any color)
