Students must be registered by **Friday, March 1, 2024** to be eligible for the lottery to select AM/PM sessions.

We will be preparing Blessing Bags for families. These bags will be assembled at Strath Haven Middle School on January 15th during the **MLK Day of Service**.

Between December 4th and January 12th NPE will be collecting **travel-size donations** for the *Care Bags*.

We are requesting the following items from each grade level:

Grade K: Hand Sanitizer, Wet Wipes, and Tissues

Grade 1: Toothpaste, toothbrush, and chapstick

Grade 2: Shampoo and Conditioner

Grade 3: Washcloths, Soap/Body Wash, and Lotion

Grade 4: Deodorant and Socks (adult size)

Grade 5: Water and individually wrapped snacks (granola bars/breakfast bars/protein bars/peanut butter or cheese crackers)

We will be accepting donations in the **front lobby** of NPE until **Friday, January 12 (boxes will be labeled by grade level)**.
